Only use Western Union to send money to friends and family. Scammers sometimes encourage people to transfer money. Do not proceed with your money transfer if you have been asked to send money to/for:

- Emergency situation you haven't confirmed.
- Individual you have not met in person.
- Anti-virus protection.
- Online purchase.
- Deposit or payment on a rental property.
- Mystery shopping assignment.
- Charity donation.
- Pay taxes.
- Credit card or loan fee.
- Claim lottery or prize winnings.
- Employment opportunity.
- Resolve an immigration matter.
- Payment for something in response to a telemarketing call.

If you send a money transfer, your receiver gets the money quickly. After the money is paid, Western Union may not be able to give you a refund, even if you're a victim of fraud, except under limited circumstances.
